Section 1 - Classifications - The Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months of age on the day of the show.

This is a combined class for dogs and bitches

Section 2 - Entry and Eligibility and eligibility requirements include:

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for all entries.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay or received payment for handling a dog. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.
- Use regular entry form and put 4-6 month puppy in the dog show class space

A class for Dogs and a class for Bitches that have placed in an AKC Licensed or Member Field Trial or who have been awarded an AKC Hunting Test Title or that have been awarded a WCA Field or Water Rating prior to the closing date of this Show. Entries in the Field Class may NOT be spayed or neutered.

VERSATILE DOGS

VERSATILE BITCHES

A class for Dogs and a class for Bitches that have been awarded any Versatile or Versatile Excellent Rating from the WCA prior to the closing date of this Show.

Entries in the Versatile Class may NOT be spayed or neutered.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition:

Dogs that are Champions of Record and Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records. If, at the end of the 90 day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC. Select Dog and Select Bitch, where applicable, will be awarded following Best of Breed.

Awards of Merit (WCA)

The judge may, at his discretion, recall into the ring up to six dogs or bitches to receive a Judge's Award of Merit.

Awards of Merit (WCWDCA)

The judge may, at his discretion, recall into the ring up to five dogs or bitches to receive a Judge's Award of Merit.

Best Veteran (WCWDCA & WCA)

Best Veteran will be selected from the First Place Winners of the Veteran Dog & Veteran Bitch classes.

Best Bred by Exhibitor (WCWDCA & WCA)

AKC SPECIAL ATTRACTION: Best Bred by Exhibitor will be selected from the First Place Winners of the Dog & Bitch Bred by Exhibitor classes. All dogs entered in the Bred-by Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. Family members must be both a breeder and owner of record to exhibit in the class. Any entry in the Bred-by-Exhibitor classes that is awarded Best of Breed or Best of Winners would automatically be Best Bred-by-Exhibitor. Only the dog or bitch not defeated in Bred-by-Exhibitor are eligible for the Best Bred-by-Exhibitor competition. One Free Litter Registration offered by the AKC.

Best Puppy (WCWDCA only)

Best Puppy will be selected from the First Place Winners of the Dog & Bitch Puppy Classes (6 months & under 9 months, 9 months & under 12 months).

POINTS AVAILABLE FOR RESERVE (WCA National Specialty only)

The Weimaraner Club of America will award at its National Specialty a three-point major to Reserve Winners Dog if the Regular Class Dog entry is twice the required number for a five-point major in the division where the National Specialty is held.

The Weimaraner Club of America will award at its National Specialty a three-point major to Reserve Winners Bitch if the Regular Class Bitch entry is twice the required number for a five-point major in the division where the National Specialty is held.

Non Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

STUD DOG CLASS: For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes or if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed Competition, but must be entered in the Stud Dog Class. The Get **MUST** be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee. This being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The Class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

BROOD BITCH CLASS: Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

(WCA Only)

BRACE CLASS: This class shall be for two dogs of the same breed (A Unit) irrespective of sex, with one or more common owner. The Brace will be judged on consistency. Dogs entered in each Brace Class unit must each also be entered in a regular or non-regular class. Show Brace Class in "Additional Class" portion of the entry form. Please note the AKC registration number or registered name of the other dog making up the brace unit on each entry form. If more than one Brace is entered by identical owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace Unit must be designated "Brace #1", "Brace #2", etc.

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form.

Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety and be eligible to compete in both the regular as well as the Owner-Handled group.
- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/ Variety will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog & Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all Champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog remaining in the ring including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If the Best of Winners is eligible, the other Winner is ineligible since it was defeated.
- No class dogs other than the Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are eligible to return to the ring.

The breed will not be represented in the Owner-Handled Group if there is no eligible dog competing in the Best of Breed or in Best of Winners competition.

* Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.

** A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend.

Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

WHAT IS THE MOST VERSATILE WEIMARANER AWARD?

This award has been established by the Weimaraner Club of America to recognize the overall versatility of the Weimaraner. The MVW Award will be presented to the Weimaraner who accumulates the most points by placing/qualifying in at least three of the various venues offered at the WCA National Specialty and/or the local club Regional Specialty during the week of Nationals.

How Does It Work?

Dogs must participate and earn points in at least three of the following eight venues (not all venues may be offered every year).

- Agility (Standard & JWW Regular or Preferred Classes in Novice, Open, Excellent, or Masters)
- Conformation (AKC only, not sweepstakes or Futurity/Maturity)
- Obedience (Regular, Graduate Novice/Open, and Versatility Classes Only)
- Rally (Regular Classes only)
- Tracking
- Shooting Ratings
- Retrieving Ratings
- Hunting Tests

Dogs may be entered in more than three venues. The dog with the highest combined total score for all venues will be awarded Most Versatile Weimaraner. Detailed rules and scoring are posted on the WCA website.

Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as possible after entries have closed. Should such acknowledgment not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Show Secretary at the listed address or telephone. (610) 376-1880. The Show Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.

Post dated checks or returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. The returned check must be made good by cash or money order before the dog(s) will be allowed in the ring. Any person that issues a check that is returned for non-payment, will be required to pay a fine of \$30.00 per check and all items with which check or checks were issued shall then be paid by cash, money order or cashier's check.

CONDITIONAL, UNSIGNED, INCOMPLETE ENTRIES received without fee will not be accepted.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Entries not on Official AKC Forms or photocopies of entry forms without rules and agreement on reverse side of Official AKC entry form are NOT acceptable.

Changes, additions, corrections or cancellations to entry forms must be received in writing by email or US Mail, signed and dated by Owner or Agent prior to the close of entries. Not acceptable by telephone.

Entries must be submitted with required entry fee on an Official American Kennel Club Form. Entries submitted in the form of telegrams or by telephone cannot be accepted.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee., or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fees due for duplicate entry or overpayment of entry fees.
