Purpose: Prepare articles for submission to the AKC Gazette breed column.

Qualifications: Must have a diversified background in the different areas of competition available to Weimaraners, with a strong understanding of dog shows as a primary area of expertise. Must have a creative ability to recognize interesting and unusual subjects to explore in the everyday world of competition and then write about them in an entertaining and informative way.

Duties:

- 1. Write four columns each year. Deadlines are January 1, April 1, July 1 and October 1.
- 2. Submitted work should be approximately 1 to 1½ double spaced pages (3 pages handwritten).
- 3. Column should be as breed specific as possible.
- 4. National events or the winners may be subjects of columns as long as they are timely.
- 5. All areas of competition may be covered.
- 6. Guest columnist may fill in in an emergency as long as they meet the guidelines and the board appointed correspondent maintains responsibility for content.
- 7. Correspondent must convey a healthy positive attitude at all times and always reflect the generally accepted opinions of AKC and WCA.
- 8. Column must never be used as a bully pulpit to promote controversial ideas and issues or individual best interests.

Board Reports: Submit report to the Secretary of the Board of Directors 6 weeks prior to each meeting of the Board of Directors.

- Summarizing activity since the last Board of Directors meeting.
- Include in the report any recommended changes regarding appointment.
