Top Ten Obedience Rules

Obedience Recorder:

- 1. On a monthly basis, submit "Top Ten Obedience Dogs QUO" and "Top Ten Obedience Dogs PAC" reports for *The Weimaraner Magazine*. The deadline for publication is the 15th of the month prior to publication (i.e. August 15 for the September issue).
- 2. Keep a record of OTCH points. List holders of OTCh points quarterly.
- 3. Inform owner of the Number One Weimaraner (QUO System) in obedience at end of year of such award. Coordinate with the editor with information for Obedience including picture of Number One Obedience Weimaraner for appropriate cover.

Computations:

Scores and placements per dog for all AKC shows, January 1 -December 31 of each year. Points are tabulated as follows:

QUO SYSTEM (Qualifying Utility/Open) (Published monthly) This recording system is for Open & Utility only. Any qualifying score earns points.

PAC SYSTEM (Placement All Classes) (Published monthly) This recording system is for all placing Weimaraners. Any dog that places first through fourth in any regular obedience class receives one point for each dog defeated. The first place dog in a 40 dog class would receive 39 points. The second, 38 points, etc. The High in Trial dog does not receive additional points.
