PERPETUAL TROPHY POLICIES

- All trophies are sole property of the Weimaraner Club of America. An inventory of the trophies
 will be maintained by the Records Committee which includes trophy location and last known
 recipient.
- 2. Only current WCA members may take temporary possession of a perpetual trophy and must sign the Trophy Receipt Form.
- 3. If the owner of the winning dog does not want to take possession of the perpetual trophy then the host club assumes the responsibility of engraving the trophy and shipping it to the next event. The owner or his handler/agent must sign the Owner Non-Possession Form.
- 4. If the owner is not present at the event the owner's handler/agent may sign the Trophy Receipt Form and take possession of the trophy. However, the owner is ultimately responsible for the trophy's welfare and shipment to the next event and is responsible for having their nameplate engraved in a manner consistent with the other engraving on the trophy.
- 5. The chairperson of the event is responsible for having all perpetual trophies present at the event. The trophies are to be clean and in presentable condition. Any damage is to be reported the Records Committee Chairman.
- 6. At the conclusion of the event the chairperson will report to the Records Committee Chairman the location of each trophy. The event chairperson will also forward all signed trophy receipts to the Records Committee Chairman.
- The Records Committee Chairman will ensure that the event chairman has all of the necessary Trophy Receipt Forms, Owner Non-Possession Forms, copies of the policies and is aware of the policies.
- 8. At the conclusion of the event the event chairperson is responsible for collecting and storing any perpetual trophies that were not claimed by the winners.
- 9. Failure to return trophies undamaged and in a timely manner may result in WCA membership suspension.
- 10. Shipping requirements and instructions are being developed and will be added soon.
