Open All-Age (One Hour Heats)	Approx. 1 PM (MST) Sun, Nov. 21, 2021	\$130.00
Field Futurity (30 Min.)	To follow the OAA	\$ 95.00
Open Gun Dog (45 Min.)	To follow the Field Futurity	\$120.00

**Courses and Birds**

All stakes shall be run on a single course. Chukar and/or quail shall be released in all stakes except the puppy stake. Chukar and/or quail will be used for retrieving – callbacks at judges' discretion. Open All Age, Open Gun Dog and Amateur Gun Dog are retrieving stakes. Horseback handling will be permitted in all stakes.

A blank cartridge will not be fired in the Puppy stake.

Tracking collars will be permitted in all stakes as per AKC rules.

**Prizes**

Standard AKC rosettes to all placed dogs. Trophy to 1<sup>st</sup> place of the stake.

WCA Rotating Trophies to the first place dog in Open All Age,  
and Amateur Gun Dog.

**Payouts**

50% of the entry fees (Net of Ground Fees and Other Such Fees) in the Open All Age  
and Open Gun Dog stakes to be divided as follows:

40%-30%-20%-10% if four placements

50%-30%-20% if three placements

70%-30% if two placements

If first through fourth place in a money stake are withheld, the prize money portion of the entries will be retained by the WCA and added to the same stake's purse next year.

Futurity placements awarded according to WCA Field Futurity Rules.

**DIRECTIONS:** Map Attached.

Coming from the South:

From Rd.3 North in Chino Valley, go North on US 89 approximately 9.1 miles to Verde Ranch Rd. (Approximately 3/10 miles past mile marker #338) Turn right onto Verde Ranch Rd. Travel East about 2 miles until the road crosses the railroad tracks.

Coming from the North:

Go South on US 89 approximately 23 miles from I-40 to Verde Ranch Rd. (Approx. 7/10 mile past mile marker #339) Turn left onto Verde Ranch Rd. Travel East about 2 miles until the road crosses the railroad tracks.

**The following instructions begin at the point where Verde Ranch Rd. crosses the railroad tracks:**

Continue to go East on Verde Ranch Rd, which is now a gravel/dirt road, for 3.8 miles. As you approach a cattle guard (the one you will have encountered) you will see a two-rut road on your left that leads to a metal pipe gate. Use this gate and follow the road to the left. It will put you on FS 9005 within 50 feet. (Be sure to leave the gate closed).

**IMPORTANT:** If you go through the cattle guard mentioned above it is not possible to make a left turn onto FS 9005 with a rig. You can make the left turn with a vehicle or with a vehicle pulling a small bumper pull trailer if you are careful.

Continue North about 1 1/2 miles until you come to a "Y." Take the road to the left. Camp is about 4 tenths of a mile, at the corral.

**PARTICIPANTS:** Are required to fill-in holes, spread horse manure, clean up after your dogs and haul your trash out.

**PRIMITIVE "DRY" CAMPING:** Is permitted, Porta-Potties on site.

**HORSES:** Please stake out your horses. No Wrangler will be available.

**WATER:** Water will be on the grounds for horses. Please bring your own water for dogs.

**WEATHER:** Please be prepared for all types of weather.

**MEALS:** Headquarters Tent for up to date information on the trial and for some Grab-n-Go meals for a nominal fee. Awards Banquet TBA.

**ATTEND AT YOUR OWN RISK:** The Weimaraner Club of America, their officers, directors, membership, host and landowners assume no responsibility for participants or spectators in the event of injury or damage to animals, persons or property.
