A neutered male may enter the Veteran Dog Class & a spayed bitch may enter the Veteran Bitch Class. 1st placements in each class may compete for Best of Breed.

FIELD CLASS ELIGIBILITY - Dogs and Bitches that have placed in an AKC Licensed or Member Field Trial or who have been awarded an AKC Hunting Test Title or that have been awarded a WCA Field or Water Rating prior to the closing date of this Show. Entries in the Field Class may NOT be spayed or neutered.

VERSATILE CLASS ELIGIBILITY - Dogs and Bitches that have been awarded any Versatile or Versatile Excellent Rating from the WCA prior to the closing date of this Show. Entries in the Versatile Class may NOT be spayed or neutered.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records. If, at the end of the 90-day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC. Select Dog and Select Bitch, where applicable, will be awarded following Best of Breed.

Awards of Merit (WCA)

The judge may, at his discretion, recall into the ring up to six dogs or bitches to receive a Judge's Award of Merit.

Awards of Merit (MHWC)

The judge may, at his discretion, recall into the ring up to four dogs or bitches to receive a Judge's Award of Merit.

Best Veteran (MHWC, WCA)

Best Veteran will be selected from the First Place Winners of the Veteran Dog & Veteran Bitch classes.

Best Bred by Exhibitor (MHWC, WCA)

Best Bred by Exhibitor will be selected from the First Place Winners of the Dog & Bitch Bred by Exhibitor classes. All dogs entered in the Bred-by Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. Family members must be both a breeder and owner of record to exhibit in the class. Any entry in the Bred-by-Exhibitor classes that is awarded Best of Breed or Best of Winners would automatically be Best Bred-by-Exhibitor. Only the dog or bitch not defeated in Bred-by-Exhibitor are eligible for the Best Bred-by-Exhibitor competition. *AKC offers 1 free Litter Registration for the WCA Best Bred-By Exhibitor award.*

Best Puppy (MHWC, WCA)

Best Puppy will be selected from the First Place Winners of the Dog & Bitch Puppy Classes (6 months & under 9 months, 9 months & under 12 months, Bred By Exhibitor Puppy).

POINTS AVAILABLE FOR RESERVE (WCA & MHWC)

The Weimaraner Club of America and Mile-High Weimaraner Club will award a three-point major to Reserve Winners Dog if the Regular Class Dog entry is twice the required number for a five-point major in the division where these Specialties are held.

The Weimaraner Club of America and Mile-High Weimaraner Club will award a three-point major to Reserve Winners Bitch if the Regular Class Bitch entry is twice the required number for a five-point major in the division where these Specialties are held.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries (National Specialty Only)

STUD DOG CLASS: For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes or if a Champion of Record, in Best of Breed Competition, but must be entered in the Stud Dog Class. The Get MUST be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee. This being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The Class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

BROOD BITCH CLASS: Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

(National Specialty Only)

BRACE CLASS: This class shall be for two dogs of the same breed (A Unit) irrespective of sex, with one or more common owner. The Brace will be judged on consistency. Dogs entered in each Brace Class unit must each also be entered in a regular or non-regular class. Show Brace Class in "Additional Class" portion of the entry form. Please note the AKC registration number or registered name of the other dog making up the brace unit on each entry form. If more than one Brace is entered by identical owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace Unit must be designated "Brace #1", "Brace #2", etc.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present or a first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show, are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class. Must notify the Superintendent/Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close have not won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who, at the times entries close, have won three first place awards in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class with competition present at a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 60 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED: Junior-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; Intermediate-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; Senior-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

AKC Junior Handler Numbers are now required for entry in Junior Showmanship Competition. Numbers may be obtained from the AKC Phone (919) 233-9767. Entry form must be filled out with the necessary information, otherwise the entry in Junior Showmanship will not be accepted.

JUMP HEIGHT MUST BE INDICATED FOR APPLICABLE CLASSES. Entries without Jump Height indicated will be judged at the end of the Class. Jump Heights in Ascending Order.

BITCHES IN SEASON are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally classes. If a female is withdrawn from competition for coming into season and the Event Secretary is notified no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class, then the entry fee for Obedience and/or Rally will be refunded. **A processing fee of \$5.00 per entry will be retained.**

4 – 6 MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION MHWC & WCA National Specialties

Male and female puppies four months and under six months will compete together, with Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex only being awarded. AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for all entries. A foreign-born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.

Puppies are required to be vaccinated in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized. AKC Rules in Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person or dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in Rules Applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise. Exhibitors should plan on opening the mouth of their puppy to show dentition for the judge to avoid transmission of illness.

Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay or received payment for handling a dog. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.

Entries will be accepted by the Show Secretary on the entry form included in this premium list. Pre-entries ONLY.

Awards: Rosettes for Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES COMPETITION – MHWC ONLY

Sweepstakes is open to all Weimaraners 6 months of age and under 24 months of age. All entries in the Sweepstakes MUST also be entered in a Regular Class at the Regular entry fee and on the same entry form at this Specialty show. Champions of record are eligible. Professional handlers allowed to handle. Indicate your entry in SWEEPSTAKES including age division in the box marked "Additional Classes.

Champions of record are eligible. Professional handlers allowed to handle Entries will be made in the Veteran Sweepstakes by indicating VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES on the entry form in the space provided for Additional Classes. Champions or record are eligible.

All dogs/bitches entered in the Futurity must be entered in one of the regular or non-regular conformation classes of the Weimaraner Club of America Specialty Show on Thursday/Friday, May 14-15, 2026. A \$30.00 entry fee is required to enter the Futurity after the dog/bitch has been properly entered in one of the regular or non-regular conformation classes. Indicate your dog's Futurity Class on the entry form in the space provided for Additional Classes.

Notice: all entries must comply with the WCA Futurity & Maturity Program rules. Exhibitor is solely responsible for knowledge of and compliance with those rules.

Classification

Senior Dog/Bitch - Born on or after June 1, 2024 through September 30, 2024
Intermediate Dog/Bitch - Born on or after October 1, 2024 through Jan. 31, 2025
Junior Dog/Bitch - Born on or after February 1, 2025 through May 31, 2025

The order of judging will be: Junior Dog, Intermediate Dog, Senior Dog, Best Dog in Futurity. Junior Bitch, Intermediate Bitch, Senior Bitch, Best Bitch in Futurity.

After which time no entries can be accepted, canceled, changed, substituted, corrected, completed or signed and no entry fees refunded. Any change or cancellation must be made in writing and received prior to closing, except as provided in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the American Kennel Club Dog Show Rules and Regulations. Fees must accompany entries; DogZibit assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. The Club and/or DogZibit assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner.
2. No Entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telegraph, FAX and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on reverse side are **not acceptable**.
